Course Description & Objectives :

By the end of this course, not only will students be able to develop their reading skills as well as strategies, but also they will be able to read English texts with good comprehension of stated information.

► Course Requirements :

All assignments must be handed in on time; we will be pressed for time in this course, and it is required that you keep up with readings and assignments. Guidelines for assignments will be announced in the first class online. You are required to watch each class during the weekends, and submit your assignment by the due date (at 10:00 a.m., by the next coming Monday).
